*PLEASE REFER TO YOUR ORDER TO REVIEW THE PROVISIONS THAT GOVERN POSSESSION OF THE CHILD FOR CERTAIN SPECIFIC HOLIDAYS THAT MAY SUPERSEDE CONFLICTING WEEKEND OR THURSDAY PERIODS OF POSSESSION WITHOUT REGARD TO THE DISTANCE THE PARENTS RESIDE APART.

- SPO INCLUDES THE 1ST, 3RD, AND 5TH WEEKEND EVERY MONTH STARTING AT 6PM ON FRIDAY – 6PM SUNDAY WITH 2 HOURS ON THURSDAY DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT.
- ESPO INCLUDES THE 1ST, 3RD, AND 5TH WEEKENDS OF EVERY MONTH FROM FRIDAY AT SCHOOL DISMISSAL TO MONDAY WHEN SCHOOL RESUMES WITH THURSDAY OVERNIGHTS DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT.
- ALSO NOTE THAT THE 5TH WEEKEND IS ALWAYS FOLLOWED BY THE NEXT MONTH’S 1ST WEEKEND
- PLEASE REFER TO YOUR CURRENT COURT ORDER FOR MORE DETAILS; YOU MAY FIND YOUR PARENTING TIME SCHEDULE IN YOUR COURT ORDER UNDER A HEADING TITLED “POSSESSION AND ACCESS ORDER” OR “STANDARD POSSESSION ORDER”.

***If your child(ren) is/are not enrolled in school, when school is referenced, you should use the scheduled for the local public school district your child would attend, based upon where your child lives.**

Standard Holidays Unaffected by Distance between Joint Managing Conservators

Mother's Day - If the mother is not otherwise entitled to possession of the child(ren) on Mother's Day, her parenting time begins on the Friday before Mother's Day and ends on Sunday at 6:00 P.M. or Monday when school resumes, depending upon your Order. Reasonable flexibility is encouraged on Mother's Day weekend.

Father's Day - If the father is not otherwise entitled to possession of the child(ren) on Father's Day, his parenting time begins on the Friday before Father's Day and ends Sunday at 6:00 P.M., or Monday at 8:00 A.M., depending upon your Order. Reasonable flexibility is encouraged on Father's Day weekend.

Child's Birthday - The parent not in possession of the child on the child's birthday is entitled to pick up the child for two hours between 6:00 P.M. and 8:00 P.M.

Spring Break/Vacation - For parents living 100 miles apart or less, spring break/vacation is divided by odd and even years. The custodial parent will have odd-numbered years and the noncustodial parent will have even-numbered years. 2023 is an odd-numbered year. Spring break/vacation begins on the day school is dismissed for spring break/vacation and ends at 6:00 P.M. on the day before school resumes.

For parents living over 100 miles apart, the noncustodial parent has possession each spring vacation. Spring break/vacation begins at 6:00 P.M. the day school is dismissed and ends at 6:00 P.M. the day before school resumes.

April 1/Annual Notice for Summer - The noncustodial parent must give written notice to the custodial parent by April 1 if the noncustodial parent wants to specify an extended period(s) of summer possession that differs from the dates provided in your parenting time order.

April 15/Annual Notice for Summer - The custodial parent must give written notice to the noncustodial parent by April 15, designating the weekend custodial parent wishes to see the child(ren) during the noncustodial parent's extended summer possession. This weekend may not interfere with Father's Day if the noncustodial parent is the father unless it interferes with Father's Day.

Without Annual Notice for Summer (Parents Reside Within 100 Miles from Each Other) - If noncustodial parent does not give custodial parent written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, noncustodial parent shall have possession of the child(ren) for thirty consecutive days in that year beginning at 6:00 P.M. on July 1 and ending at 6:00 P.M. on July 31.

Without Annual Notice for Summer (Parents Reside Outside of 100 Miles from Each Other) - If noncustodial parent does not give custodial parent written notice by April 1 of a year specifying an extended period or periods of summer possession for that year, noncustodial parent shall have possession of the child(ren) for forty-two consecutive days beginning at 6:00 P.M. on June 15 and ending at 6:00 P.M. on July 27 of that year.

Thanksgiving - This holiday is divided by odd and even years. The noncustodial parent will have odd-numbered years and the custodial parent will have even-numbered years. 2023 is an odd-numbered year. Thanksgiving visitation begins the day school dismisses for the holiday and ends at 6:00 P.M. on the following Sunday or when school resumes, depending upon your Order.

Christmas Holidays (Christmas A and B)

Christmas A - In odd-numbered years, the custodial parent's visitation begins the day school dismisses for the holiday and ends on December 28th at noon. The noncustodial parent will have even-numbered years. 2023 is an odd-numbered year.

Christmas B - In even-numbered years, the custodial parent's visitation begins on December 28th at noon and ends at 6:00 P.M. on the day before school resumes from the vacation. The noncustodial parent will have odd-numbered years. 2023 is an odd-numbered year.
